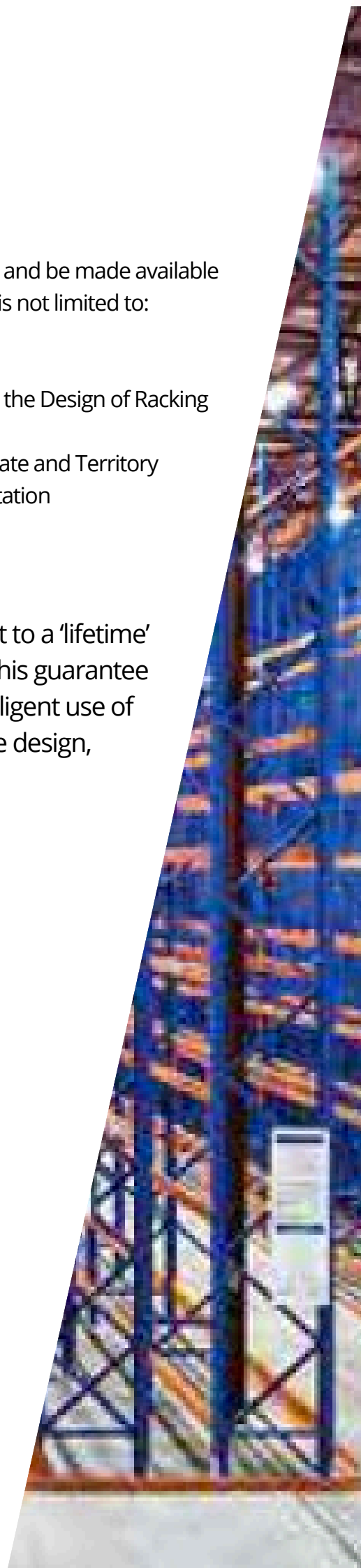

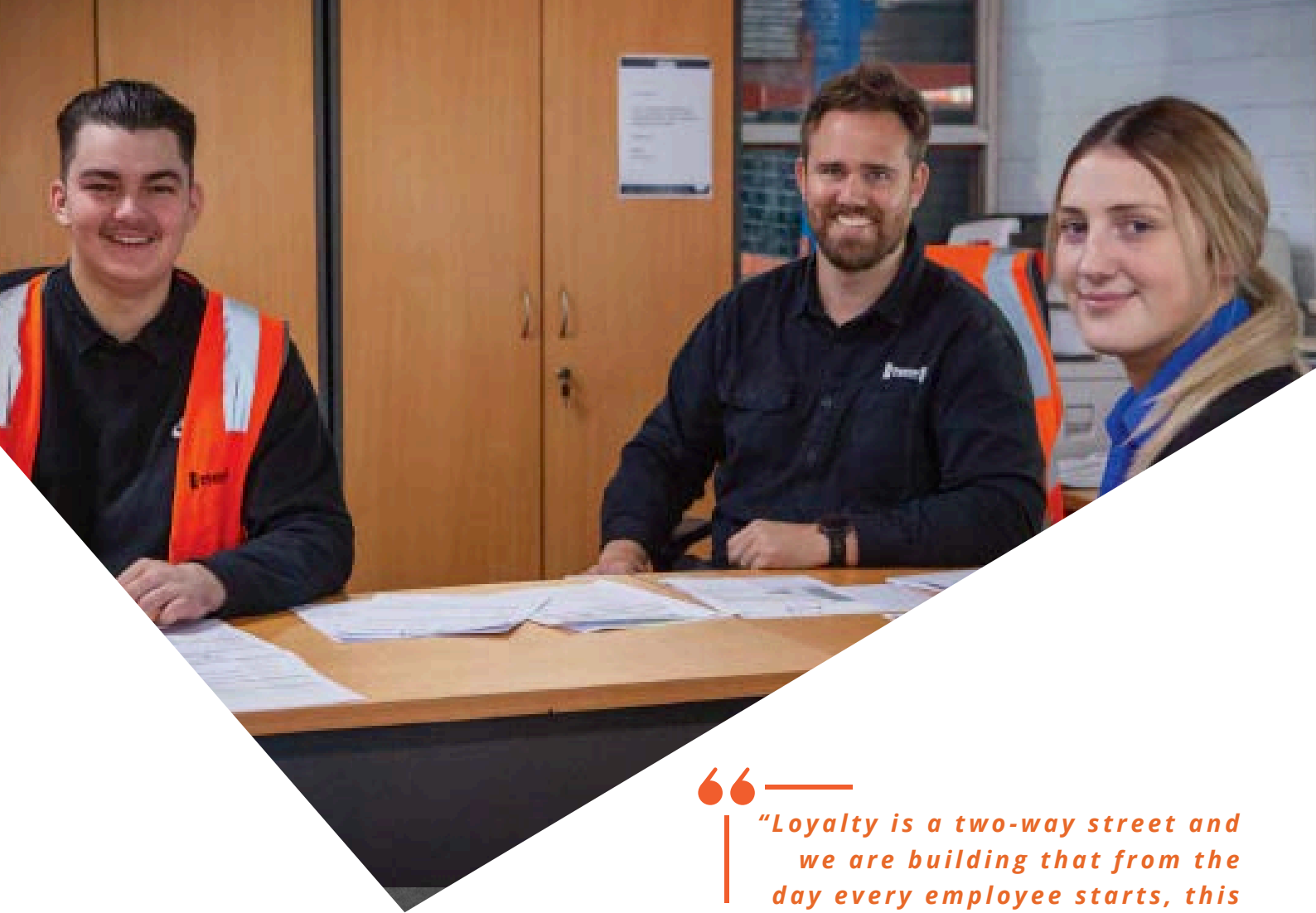
WARRANTY

FREIGHT

Rackman Australia has several national freight suppliers allowing us to supply the best possible freight solutions for our national clients. Freight out of WA and SA is the most cost-effective freight in Australia, with costs being as low as 40% of freight travelling from East to West. We are regularly able to supply to capital cities in Australia at rates that make our product more cost-effective from either of our SA or WA warehouses. Local deliveries are completed mainly with our own fleet of trucks and plant trailers, assisting us to be on time and not rely on other contractors for deliveries and transport safety.
